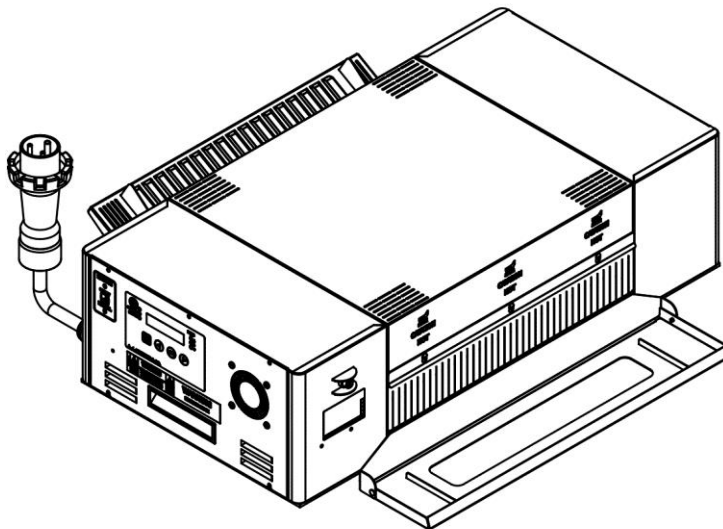

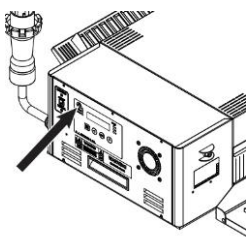

Procedure

1 Turn off Toaster.

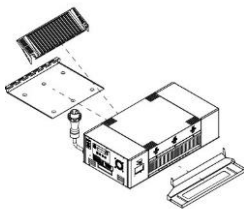
Press the power button on the control panel to turn the toaster off. The toaster enters a cool-down mode and automatically shuts down when complete.

2 Remove and clean the accessories.

Remove the accessories with heat-resistant gloves and take to the 3-compartment sink to wash, rinse, and sanitize. Allow to air dry or dry with a clean, paper towel.

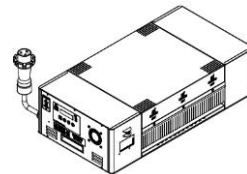


Chemicals

3 Clean outside of toaster.

Clean the outside surfaces of the toaster with a paper towel dampened with KAY QSR Glass & Multi-Surface Cleaner. Discard towel in soiled towel bucket after use. Allow to air dry.

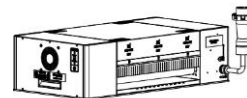

4 Inspect Wire Belt

Inspect the Wire Belt for excessive stretch. The belt should be tight and without slack or sagging. Remove links if there is too much slack.

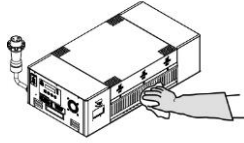

5 Clean Wire Belt

Clean the Wire Belt with a clean sanitized towel sprayed with KAYQUAT II Sanitizer Solution for one revolution.



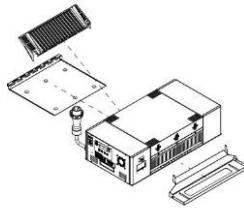

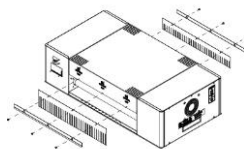
- 1 Turn off toaster.**

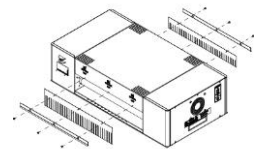
- 2 Remove accessories.**
Put on heat resistant gloves and remove the accessories from the toaster.



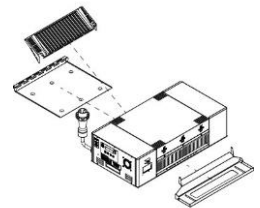
- 3 Remove Damper Curtains.**
Remove the three screws from the Damper Curtains. Remove Bracket and set aside with screws. Do this for the front and rear sides of the toaster.



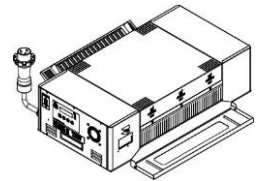
- 4 Install new Damper Curtains.**
Install the new Damper Curtains and secure with the Bracket and three screws. Do this for the front and rear sides of the toaster.




- 5 Re-attach Accessories.**

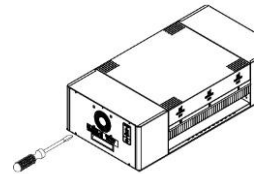
- 3 Open Left Side Panel.**
Loosen the two bottom screws and remove the three top screws from the left side panel. Lay the panel down carefully as shown. Do not disconnect any wires.



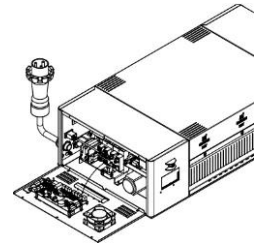
- 4 Clean Left Side Fan.**
Using the nylon-bristled brush, remove all lint and debris from the fan blades and surrounding area.



- 5 Close Left Side Panel.**
Re-attach the left side panel and secure with the screws.



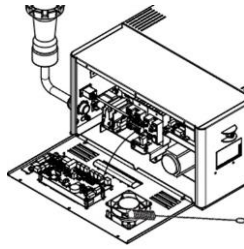
- 6 Open Right Side Panel.**
Loosen the two bottom screws and remove the three top screws from the right side panel. Lay the panel down carefully as shown. Do not disconnect any wires.

Clean Cooling Fans (continued)

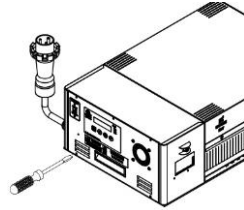
7 Clean Right Side Fan.

Using the nylon-bristled brush, remove all lint and debris from the fan blades and surrounding area.



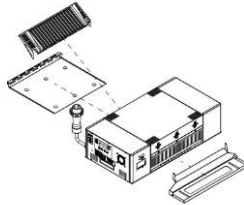
8 Close Right Side Panel.
